COVID-19 VACCINES

Governor Tim Walz has announced that **ALL Minnesotans aged 16 and older** are eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine starting Tuesday, March 30. While the order includes those ages 16 and older, **Nobles County is currently administering the Moderna vaccine, approved for ages 18 and older only.**

To help all those eligible receive the vaccine, Nobles County Public Health will be completing mobile vaccine clinics in the following communities: Adrian, Brewster, Ellsworth, Round Lake, and Wilmont.
