Tribune receives letter from Pvt. Ray Kremer - Dear Pete, Have been receiving the Wilmont paper every week since I've been in the Army; it sure is something to look forward to when a fellow is away from home. I want to thank you a lot for send it. This Army life isn't so bad but could be better. This going to school reminds me of six years ago when I used to do the same thing every day. We go to school at night now. We are on the 11 p.m. to the 7 a.m. shift. They call it the "Grave Yard Shift", and it really hits the nail on the head. Boy, when you look around in the classroom you sure can see a lot of men falling to sleep. It is really hard to stay awake. I know, because I fell asleep myself. But I'm glad I had this opportunity to take this course because I have really learned a lot since I've been here. The climate around here is similar to that at home, cold on day and hot the next. The Capital of Wisconsin is a very beautiful building. It stand right in the center of the city. You can't get lost as long as you can see it. There are a bunch of men who are graduating today. When we came here ti Madison, our Captain gave us a talk. He told us that our Mission was to be the best operator in the Air Corp. Well, I've been working pretty hard for that Mission, but I don't think I can make the grade. All a fellow can do is try, and everyone of us is doing just that. We., Pete, I haven't much time left, so I'll close saying, thanks a lot for the paper. Prat. Ray Kremer

Leo Kuhl, who has been working at Omaha, Nebraska, enlisted in the Air Corp and later will be in Fort Worth, Texas.

In the village of Wilmont at the Public School you can register from 4 p.m. until 8 p.m. on both days and also on Saturday, if necessary. Miss Davis, Miss Einck, W. J. Sievers, and Barney Kuhl will be there to help with the registration.

We, Red Cross volunteers, have moved our work room over to the Public school house, on the second floor, room to the right at the head of the stairs. We do sewing and knitting every Wednesday afternoon, 2 to 5 o'clock; surgical dressings every Friday afternoon from 2 to 5, at the same place. Has someone a sewing machine we could use at the Red Cross room for a month? Bring it to the school. You are invited and welcome to come and sew any time, or, if you wish, you may take your sewing or knitting home with you.

From Nobles County History by Arthur Rose 1907

Henry Peterburs is a farmer and stock raiser of Willmont Township and an early settler of that precinct. He owns the northeast quarter of section 30 and the southeast quarter of section 23. Mr. Peterburs was born in Westphalia, Germany, Nov. 13, 1853, the son of Frank and Gertie (Langhorst) Peterburs. The father, who was a farmer by occupation, died in Germany, when our subject was eleven years of age, at the age of 56 years. Mrs. Peterburs died one week later, at the age of 50 years. Until he was 27 years old Henry resided in his native land, and was raised on a farm. During the last six years of his residence there he was employed as a stage and mail driver. On the 26th of August, 1880, Mr. Peterburs arrived in Adrian direct from Germany, his earthly possessions consisting of twenty dollars. He rented a farm on section 4, Westside Township, and farmed there one year. He then worked out six months for a farmer by the name of Faulklander. Mr. Peterburs then moved to Scott County, Minn., where he worked on the railroad two years. Two years more were spent in the same occupation in Minneapolis, and then, in April, 1886, he returned to Nobles County. He at once bought a relinquishment to a tree claim comprising the southwest quarter of section 20, Willmont Township, changed the filing to a homestead, moved onto the place and proved up on it. There he lived, engaging in farming, until the spring of 1904. He then sold out and moved onto his present farm, which he had purchased in 1896. He engages in general farming and stock raising. Mr. Peterburs was married at Shakopee, Minn., May 8, 1883 to Mary Ghole, who was born in Hanover, Germany, July 18, 1862. Mr. and Mrs. Peterburs are the parents of five children: Lizzie (Mrs. Henry Stuntebeck), of Willmont, born Oct. 26, 1884; Frank, born Aug. 18, 1891; Gertie, born Sept 26, 1894; Henry, born Aug. 17, 1897; Mary born Sept. 15, 1902. The family are members of the Catholic Church of St. Kilian, and Mr. Peterburs is one of the church trustees. He has held the office of school director of District No. 66 for 3 years. He was one of the organizers of the Farmers' Elevator Company of Lismore and is now a director of the company. He is treasurer of the Farmers' Store Company of St. Kilian.

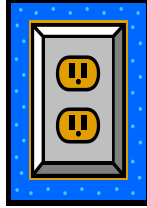
