Years Ago—By Audrey Brake Thanks for the many memories!

Taken from the June 24 & July 1, 1943 Wilmont Tribune & July 2, 1943 Lismore Free Press

Wilmont

Pfc. Lawrence N. Schwartz, 28, son of Mrs. J. P. Schneider of southern Larkin Township, became another on the lengthening list of Nobles County North African casualties on June 3, as learned by his mother Saturday in a message from the war department. The same day came a terse, but sympathy letter from the Rev. F. B. Gaffney, chaplain of a hospital at Souk Ahras in northeastern Algeria, south of Bone, stating the Pfc. Schwartz had been buried in the Catholic cemetery there. This was taken by the family to indicate that the Larkin soldier died in the hospital, presumably of disease. Exactly what happened will not be known until the written particulars are given. Pfc. Schwartz was last heard from by his relatives here three weeks ago, through a letter written May 12, at which time he seemed to have been in good health. It was exactly two years ago, June 9, since Pfc. Schwartz was inducted at Ft. Snelling. He had been in North Africa since December 23, 1942. Members of the family said Monday that the thoughtfulness of the Army chaplain at Souk Ahras, in writing Mrs. Schneider that her son had received Christian burial did much to soften the shock accompanying the death message. Besides his mother and step father, Pfc. Schwartz is survived by three sisters and one brother, Mrs. Ed Rowelling of Adrian and Lorraine and Anna Mae Schneider and Alfred Schwartz on the home place. He had one niece, Sharon Kay Roemeling at Adrian. The last time Pfc. Schwartz was home was in August, 1942, when he had a 10-day furlough.

Those who attended were Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Scholtes and Sharon, Mr. and Mrs. Leo Scholtes and family, Mr. and Mrs. Fabian Scholtes and family, Mr. and Mrs. William Brake and Jim, Mr. and Mrs. John Palmer of Windom, and Mr. and Mrs. Edward Zawacki of Minneapolis.

Art Wulf showed pictures of the Turkey Parade at Worthington from last fall, which was enjoyed by all. Lunch and refreshments were served after the meeting.


