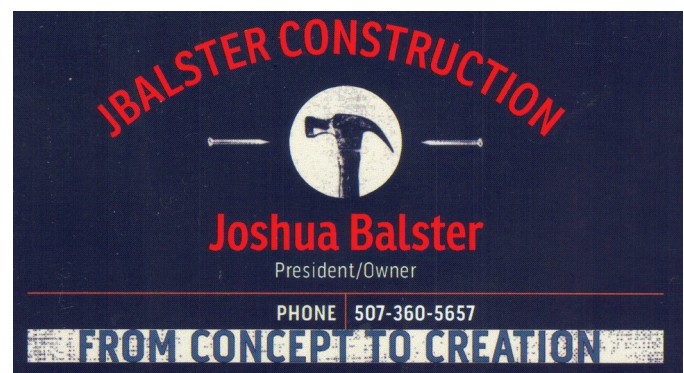
Glenn was diagnosed at the end of January 2022 with Invasive Ductal Carcinoma. He underwent 20 weeks of chemo followed by a mastectomy in August and then 30 sessions of radiation. The surgery removed two tumors along with 13 lymph nodes of which six were found to be cancerous. Unfortunately there were two lymph nodes which remain and are termed to be highly suspicious. These areas received higher doses of radiation. Glenn will be receiving medications to help keep the cancer at bay as well additional scans and tests.
