

You will hear about the beginnings of the G.A.R. and the early struggles to define the organization. The decades-long struggle for the expansion of pensions for veterans was the high tide of political influence of the Grand Army of the Republic.

The Woman's Relief Corps and its caring of disabled veterans led to the creation of Old Soldiers Homes. The W.R.C was instrumental in the efforts to place the U.S. flag and Pledge of Allegiance into our nation's schools.
