Mr. and Mrs. Nic Broich have recently received two certificates, one signed by President Roosevelt, which was In Memory of Pfc. Cletus F. Broich, A.S.N. 37116578, who died in the service of his country in the European Area, July 29th, 1944. He stands in the unbroken line of Patriots who have dared to die that Freedom might live, grow, and increase its blessings. Freedom lives and through it, he lives. In a way that humbles the undertakings of most men. Franklin D. Roosevelt. The other certificate was: To certify that the President has awarded the Purple Heart to Pfc. Cletus Broich, A.S.N. No. 37116578 for Military Merit and for wounds received in action, resulting in his death July 29th, 1944. Henry L. Stimson, Secretary of War

McCAnn, John Probst, Joe Probst, Paul Probst, John Pacholl, Clem Schlichte, Joe N. Scholtes, Leo Scholtes, W. J. Sievers, Hub Slater, Ed Vaske, P. J. Wagner, Art Wulf, and George Moser.

Phelps-Drake Company, contractors of Minneapolis, who were low bidders for the 4000 feet of 4-inch water main in the village of Wilmont, completed their job Wednesday of this week, which was done in record time. Wilmont residents can be proud of the fine water mains that this village now has. Fire protection can't be beat, as we have ten fire hydrants scattered throughout the city. The ditch was dug seven feet deep to prevent freezing, which should be done in putting in any water mains. This job was also approved by the State Board of Health. Claude Zebetner, registered engineer of Ivanhoe, drew up the plans.

Wm. Schissel, who suffered a heart attack at his home early Sunday morning, was taken to the Worthington Clinic Hospital at Worthington Sunday evening. Mr. Schissel never gained consciousness and passed away Wednesday morning at 2 a.m. He was 65 years old and a resident of this vicinity for over 35 years. As yet no funeral arrangements have been made.

Tonight, Wednesday, the boys will meet the fast Iona basketball team at the school gym. Game to start at 7:30 sharp. Admission 15 and 25 cents. Come to this game and cheer for the home boys.


