

Pfc. Marvin M. Menke, 25, son of Mr. and Mrs. Leo Menke, was killed in action in Belgium January 30, a war department message to his parents disclosed Monday. Pfc Menke would have been in the service three years had he lived until last Saturday, February 10, and went overseas a year ago last August 10. Until December 10 last, he had been attached to supreme headquarters allied expeditionary force, but on that date succeeded in getting a transfer to combat duty. His mother said Monday that actual arrival of the message came in a sense as an anti-climax. For the previous week she had sensed that he was either in grave danger, had been wounded, or had been killed. This was heightened by an unaccountable rumor in circulation about him around Lismore, which never quite assumed definite shape. The same forenoon that the message came, the Menke's received two letters from Marvin, assuring them of his safety. Apparently he had not heard from home since November.

#### Letter to the Citizens of Wilmont Township:

Wilmont Township decided to replace a culvert on the road West of Section 2 Wilmont Township. The culvert appears to be in good condition and we were told they will not replace it if they cannot lower it. They want to lower the water level in the wetland in Section 3. The only people that will benefit will be a select few to the West. This will cause flooding in Section 2 because of the DNR dam in Section 1. They had a contractor and everything there to do this on Friday, November 17, 2023 and the DNR stopped the project. They were told by a DNR Official that had spoken with the township representatives several times ``Same size, same elevation with an authorized permit". DNR told the Township if the culvert was going to be lowered, they needed a hydrology study on the water system starting with the DNR dam in Section 1 and going to the West. If the Wilmont Township Board decides to do this it will be a substantial cost to the Wilmont Township taxpayers. We spoke to one of the County Commissioners who said if the West culvert is lowered all downstream culverts, dams and structures need to be lowered the same. My question to the voters is how do you want your tax dollars spent? So that only a certain few can benefit?
