

**YEARS AGO—written by Audrey Brake— Thanks Audrey for all these memories!**

**Wilmont**

Mr. and Mrs. Oscar Kuhl had word from their son, Richard, on Monday that he had graduated on June 14th from Yoeman's School at San Diego, Cal. Richard was 8th highest out of a class of 50. He is being transferred to Washington, D.C. soon.

Staff Sergeant Glenn C. Huhnstock, a senior gunner and only son of Mr. and Mrs. Carl Huhnstock of Mankato, Minn. and brother to Mrs. Fabian Scholtes of Wilmont has been listed as presumably dead by the war department. Glenn was reported as missing in action over Japan in the 20th bomber command of B-29's on June 5th 1945. S-Sgt. Huhnstock enlisted in the Army before Pearl Harbor on March 23, 1941 in the quartermaster corps. He received his training at Camp Roberts and San Luis Obispo, Cal. In April, 1942, he entered the Air Corps and trained at Maxwell Field, Ala., Carlstrom Field, Fla., and at Bainbridge Field, Ga. He then was transferred to a gunner's school at Buckley Field and at Lowry Field, Denver in June, 1943, going from there to Salina, Kansas. He went overseas in April, 1944. He landed in Egypt and spent some time in Iran and India. His group, the General Billy Mitchell, earned a group insignia, in the 20 bomber command. S-Sgt. Huhnstock arrived somewhere in the Pacific in May, 1945 and was reported missing three weeks later, after being on a combat mission to Koba, Japan. During the mission, Glenn's aircraft was attacked and damaged by enemy fighter planes. When about 48 miles east of Osaka, Japan at least nine and possibly eleven parachutes were seen to leave the plane before it crashed on a hill. No report has been received of the fate of 10 of the crew.

Memorial services, as yet have not been arranged. Glenn leaves to mourn of the immediate family, his wife, Mrs. Mary Lou Huhnstock and two-year-old daughter, Cheryl Sue of Denver, Col., his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Carl Huhnstock of Mankato and two sisters, Mrs. Fabian Scholtes of Wilmont and Mrs. Lenus Tuberg now of Mankato.

On last Sunday, following the regular church services, the congregation of the Presbyterian Church of Wilmont, assembled for a dinner in the church dining room, honoring Dr. and Mrs. J. D. Waller, who left on Tuesday to make their home in Pine City, Minnesota. Following the dinner and a social hour Rev. Thomas D. Arendt of Little Rock, Iowa, who together with his wife and daughter were present, was called upon and in a very fine way he paid tribute to the work of Dr. and Mrs. Waller in the community they have served so long. His talk was full of warmth and humor as he recalled some of the events during the years they were here.

Rev. E. W. Corbit, the present pastor, in behalf of the congregations presented a purse of Silver to the good Doctor and his wife, which was graciously received with a few well-chosen words by Dr. Waller. The congregation, together with the entire community feel a sense of deep loss, with the going of Dr. and Mrs. Waller. During the years he has served the community and together they have stood for all that was best. Wishing them enjoyment to the fullest at their new home on the lake side. The First Presbyterian church and the people of Wilmont and the surrounding territory.

The Commissioner of Education, Dean Schweikhard, from the Minnesota State Dept. gave the address to 160 pupils who graduated from the 8th grade in Nobles County on Tuesday afternoon, June 18, at 2:30 in the high school auditorium in Worthington. Graduates from Wilmont were Jimmie Hindt and Diana Johnson from District 104 and from Our Lady of Good Counsel School were Diana Ahmann, Donald and Harold Bertrand, Margaret Cuddigan, Arvid Einck, Edna Galles, Alan Gerber, Dale Hendel, Laverne Pacholl, Charles Probst, Joyce Schissel, Daryl Schlichte, Gerald Sieve, Catherine Spartz, Louella Voss, James Wagner, and Thomas Slater.

Complaints were brought to this office this morning about children in the village of Wilmont throwing stones or whatever they happen to get their hands on at small Morning Doves in the trees of the former Dr. Waller's residence. Parents should instruct their children not to do those things, especially to those kind of birds.

It was a pitcher's battle between Sanders of Iona and Faber for the locals. Both men pitched real ball throughout the entire game. Iona scored their first run in the 4th inning. They were held scoreless from then on until the 11th inning when B. Wagner singled, followed by Meyer's single, sending Wagner to third and scoring on a fielder's choice from short to home. Warner was called safe by umpire Kellen behind the plate. The locals were held scoreless until the 8th inning when they scored one run on one hit by Schlichte and 2 errors were committed by Iona. Players for Wilmont were: Scholtes - cf, Shelquist - 2b, O. Kuhl - 3b, E. Kuhl - c, Cosgriff - rf, Faber - p, Springman - 1b, Baker - lf, Schlichte - ss, Probst


