Robert enlisted in the Army National Guard in November of 1989. Robert graduated from Worthington High School in 1990. 

**Wilmont**

If weather permits this coming Sunday, October 6th at Wilmont ball park at 2 p.m., baseball fans will see, free of charge, a baseball game between Joe Probst and W. J. Sievers team and the Kuhl and Wagner team. W. J. has in mind that they can pick up a team that will give the Kuh/Wagner family team a real battle, but that will have to be proven before we will agree with him. As far as can be learned at this writing we don't know who will play on W. J.'s team, but you can bet that he will have a good line-up. The line-up for the Kuhl/Wagner families team probably will be as follows: Matt Wagner, catching; Barney Kuhl, pitching; Ben Wagner at first, Dim Wagner at second, Elmer Kuhl at short, Bud Kuhl at third, Leo Kuhl in left field, P. J. Wagner in center field and Lester Kuhl in right field. Better look that lineup over W. J. and J. P., as Faber (Wilmont's town team pitcher) would do you boys a lot of good in this game. W. J. may be the starting pitcher. Do you get it - I mean the starting pitcher? This will be a game that you will not want to miss. Let's all hope for a good day Sunday.

The Kuhl and Wagner ball team didn't pan out so hot Sunday. At the end of the 9th inning the score read 2 to 1 in favor of W.J. and J.P.'s. team. It's like the old saying, it takes runs to win a ball game. No score was kept, so the hits cannot be given. Barney Kuhl and Clair Springman were the pitchers and they both pitched a nice game.

Jake Fath, local Funk's "G" sales representative, just returned from a trip to the home office for this area of Funk Bros. Seed Company at Belle Plaine, Iowa. While there he had an opportunity to see the seed corn dryers operated by the company, the grading system and the research work being done by Funk Bros. The company has one of their breeding nurseries located near Belle Plaine. This is a 25-acre field where new inbreds and new hybrids are made by hand pollinations. W. H. Magdefrau, who is in charge of the nursery, told the group that 8,200 hand pollinations were made in this nursery last year using 10,000 tassel bags and 20,000 shoot bags. The work required four foremen and over 20 people working for a period of nearly 3 weeks. 420 different inbreds and single crosses were represented in the field. This is one of several breeding nurseries operated by the company, another being at Spencer, Ia., one at Harmony, Minn., 3 in Illinois and several more at other points. Jake reported a very enjoyable trip and very worthwhile.

Lloyd O. Densmore and Mrs. Mary Albright of Long Beach, Cal. exchanged marriage vows Saturday afternoon, August 31st. The bride is from Kokomo, Indiana. Mr. and Mrs. William Lawrence attended the couple. The reception was given in the Lawrence home. The bridegroom, son of Mr. and Mrs. Frank H. Densmore of Long Beech, served overseas with the Armed Forces during the war. He is employed by the Register. Best wishes are extended to Lloyd and his wife by their many friends in this vicinity. (Frank Densmore published the Wilmont Tribune many years before selling it in 1937 to Pete Wagner. The Densmore's then moved to California.)

While testing cattle Saturday at the J. W. Smith farm, Frank (Red) Balster, Jr. had a painful accident happen to him. One of the cows got Frank down and shoved him against a tree stump, fracturing three ribs and bruising him up. Frank is getting along fine but it pretty stiff.

The Veterans of Foreign Wars will sponsor a war picture show at the Wilmont School gym on Wednesday evening, October 16, at 8 o'clock P.M. It will be free to the public and a good size crowd is expected.

For a real treat, stop at the new "KEE Theater" and get a bag of that delicious, crunchy, hot popcorn.

Judith Ann Malecek, 88, of Sacred Heart, died Friday April 10, 2026, at the CentraCare - St. Cloud Hospital, St. Cloud, MN. Judith Ann Gerde was born on June 4, 1937, in Hawk Creek Township, Renville County to Bertram and Mabel (Marks) Gerde. She grew up on the family farm southwest of Sacred Heart and attended Sacred Heart Public School where she graduated as Valedictorian in 1955, then attended Augsburg College. After college she worked at Warner Manufacturing. Judith was united in marriage to Desmond Malecek on June 10th, 1956, at Trinity Lutheran Church in Sacred Heart where they also made their home. She was the bookkeeper for Desmond's Amoco Service and worked at the Sacred Heart News. Judy attended Our Savior's Lutheran Church and especially enjoyed helping with VBS, singing in choir, sewing banners and was the church librarian. Judy loved children, the arts, and music. Listening to Johnnie Ray songs was her favorite. Judy also volunteered for school programs such as Junior Great Books and was a substitute aid for Special Education. Judy loved to take Sunday afternoon "drives" with Desmond or just go fishing with her family. If the fish didn't bite, out came the crochet hook. She was talented with many handicrafts including sewing, quilting, painting and crochet.

Once her family was grown, Judy spent untold hours researching her own family's genealogy, poring over newspaper clippings, county and church records, and taking trips in the upper Midwest doing research at burial sites. In 1984 she published the chronological record of the descendants of Ole Pederson Gjerde and Pernille Larsdatter Gjerde, tracing her lineage from 1852 to 1984. At the Sacred Heart Area Museum and Historical Society, she volunteered as publicity director from 1996-98, and as an editor of the Society's newsletter. She especially enjoyed helping others locate their family history. She traveled to Norway and was able to tell distant relatives there what had become of their loved ones who emigrated to the United States.

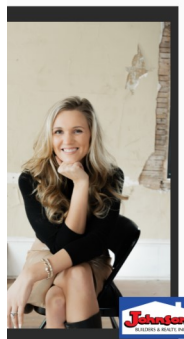
