Photo From the Past

The photo this week is from June of 1950 when Nobles County Library opened a Wilmont Branch in the Schroer-Hurlbut (Honus & Alice Schroer and Sadie Hurlbut) Cafe which was located in the former Sr. Citizens Building on Main Street. This building was taken down when the community of Wilmont decided to build the new community center in that location. Several hundred books were placed on the shelves near the window, located in the southwest corner, of the building. The books were changed monthly to provide a variety of reading. The library was established through the efforts of the Wilmont Auxiliary of the VFW. Mrs. Don Moser, chaplain of the auxiliary, did much of the work. There was no charge for borrowing books. Anyone taking out a book just had to sign a card in the pocket on the inside cover of the book and place the card in a file in the library. The Wilmont VFW Auxiliary, which sponsored the library, also made Christmas packages to local shut-ins and helped in the operation of the VFW Club kitchen at various activities. 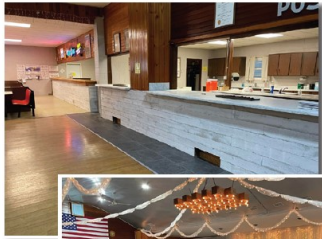

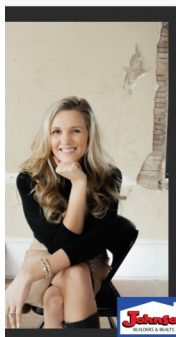
